Many publishers still do not perceive Telegram as an effective platform for attracting traffic. Usually they use other resources for gambling and betting, such as websites, social networks, display advertising and mobile applications.

Telegram is often overlooked despite being one of the most convenient tools of promotion that tolerates gambling products.

We will give you 7 recommendations that can help you squeeze the most out of Telegram!

# Don't spread yourself thin

Telegram users appreciate specificity, so it's important to choose a clear topic. Although the promotion of offers in the gambling vertical may appear to be a narrow niche, several directions can be distinguished in it:

- Reviews of slots:
- Strategies and schemes of the game;
- Stories about big wins;
- Gambling news

Do not try to cover everything at once - it will only disperse the attention of subscribers and reduce the chances of attracting them to online casinos. From time to time publish offers with call to action - that's what you get paid for.

**Catchy name** 

The name should be:

- Short and catchy so it's easy to remember;
- Carry specificity so it's searchable by keywords

# Juicy logo

Of course, you can use just a letter as the main picture, but this will put an end to any further development of your channel. You will be left to change the niche and forget about affiliate marketing in gambling. The logo should reflect the theme of your Telegram channel, because it is its face. Despite the small size of the image, you can put a specific meaning behind it and convey a desired message.

# Constantly changing and interesting content

Just like a casino website or landing page, the content in your Telegram channel should be useful.

If there are just a few outdated articles circling around in your feed, then you can forget about engagement. Gambling events are happening all the time, so there will be plenty of topics for publications: releases of new slots, big wins, new strategies and schemes for different slots.

With an active audience a word of mouth will take effect. - Players will bring their friends, which expands the reach of your offers and boosts your income.

# **Channel catalogs**

As soon as you have a beautiful logo, a clever name and at least 20 posts your channel becomes qualified to be added to corresponding catalogs. Telegram hosts plenty of channels on different topics, both paid and free. Such resources are well ranked which leads to a higher likelihood of your channel to be found.

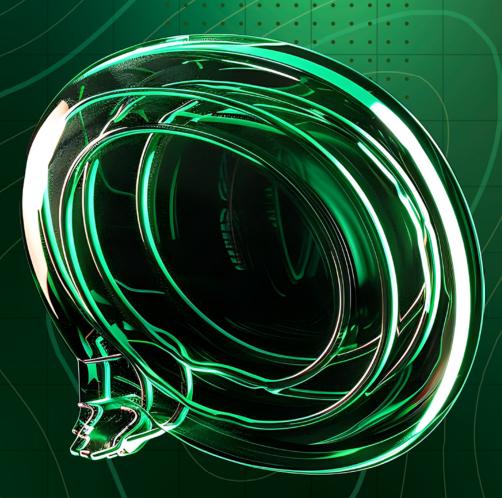
# Mutual PR: Look for similar channels and offer to exchange links.

This is beneficial to both parties, although not everyone will agree to do it for free at first. After a 1000 subscribers offers will start coming to you. Such an exchange will quickly attract new subscribers.

### Comments

You can advertise your Telegram in social networks, forums and blogs. Participate in discussions, leave links where possible. If you can't insert a direct link, you can obscurely mention your channel in the comments.

These tips will help you promote your Telegram channel in a low-cost way. If you follow them regularly, affiliate marketing may well grow into a full-fledged business. Taking into account that the gambling niche is not yet well developed, in this messenger you will have a good chance of success.



Syndicate team shared the main reasons for Facebook account blocking and ways to minimize them.

# Unobvious reasons for blocking FB accounts

Facebook moderation is based on neural networks. This means that blocking can happen for subjective reasons. For example, the system can ban an account, even if the campaigns are perfectly legal. To reduce the risk of getting banned, start with using trusted accounts.

# What is account trust and how to increase it?

Trust is the level of trust Facebook has on your profile. The higher the trust, the less likely you are to be blocked. You can increase trust in a number of ways:

**Buying accounts** - you should look for such profiles in webmaster chats or specialized stores. Read reviews before buying, as the market changes frequently.

- Account rental such accounts should be sought from real users or special online agencies. They are usually more expensive, but have a higher level of trust.
- Farming accounts create a profile, use a temporary number and actively warm it up for a few weeks by publishing posts and responding to content.

Trust can be gauged by how Facebook responds to ads being run from that account. The age of the profile and the quality of the consumables used in its creation are important.

# Role of anonymity and uniqueness in affiliate marketing

Work through anti-detect browsers and mobile proxies from Tier-1 countries, set up cloaking when working with gray offers. Avoid frequent visits to accounts and don't make drastic changes to avoid any attention from moderators.

Keep in mind, the less often you use the same creatives, domains or proxies, the harder it will be for Facebook's moderation systems to track patterns. Hence, this will protect you from blocking your accounts.

# Types of bans

A webmaster should understand why he can be banned. There are 4 main types of bans:

- Violation of advertising policy. The most common type of blocking, which is caused by: the use of non-unique content, aggressive ads, advertising of medical products or erotica. To avoid such bans, work with quality consumables and avoid aggressive advertising strategies.
- Advertising ban. Occurs when suspected of violating the rules. You will need to send scans of documents such as passport or ID to pass the check. Neural networks can be used to generate such images.
- Risk Payment. Related to problems in linking payment data. Reasons for blocking include lack of trust in the bank and insufficient balance. To reduce the risk, link the card when Facebook offers to do so, and let the account settle before running ads.
- Bypass systems. Such blocking is possible if you are suspected of bypassing moderation, for example, when using cloaking. You can avoid it by using unique landing pages and fresh domains.

Do not forget that blocking is a part of a webmaster's job. By following these recommendations, you will reduce risks and make your campaigns more stable

# FINANCE BETTING AND HR

### **Financial Vertical**

### **Entry Threshold**

It depends on the traffic source and funnel. For example, with PPC, the starting point is around \$1000, ideally \$2000-\$3000. From \$5000 to \$10000, you can conduct a full-scale testing of several hypotheses, attempt scaling your volumes or estimate ROI. With other traffic sources, you can start with \$500-\$1000.

### GEO

Russia. If you have the skills, you can target LATAM or Asia. If you're interested in Europe, Spain would be a good option.

## Challenges

High competition and scaling difficulties.

### **Advantages**

This is a stable, long-term vertical: white-hat and licensed, so there are no issues with bans. While it may not be as profitable as iGaming, it is the leader among other white-hat verticals.

# What is the entry threshold in the HR vertical?

You can start experimenting with \$200-\$300, but to earn substantial profits, it's better to prepare a few thousand USD.

### GEO

The international market is growing, but the best and most developed offers are still in Russia.

### Challenges

The main traffic source is job boards, which often involves complicated registration processes and restrictions. Approval times can be long due to delays from advertisers.

Constant adjustments are needed, and sometimes you have to find new places to redirect traffic due to limits or frequently changing GEOs of offers.

### **Advantages**

Low competition, white-hat status, and a constantly growing vertical. With the right skills, you can achieve huge ROI.

### **Betting Vertical**

# **Entry Threshold**

Although this is a white-hat vertical, it's not the easiest to break into. You can test a funnel with 300-500 USD, but you'll need to be creative with prelanding, landing pages and ad texts, especially if you're using Yandex or VK.

On the bright side, you can experiment with less typical traffic sources—adult, spam, ads in public channels, and teaser networks.

### **GEO**

Russia.

# Challenges

Advertising laws: specific requirements for websites to host ads and an almost complete ban on direct advertising via Yandex and VK.

### **Advantages**

A wide target audience that overlaps well with finance and gambling. Fast turnover: conversions take minutes, not days or months. Low minimum deposit amount results in high conversion rates from the traffic you run. The funnel is straightforward, and the stats are transparent. You can achieve a high EPC if you find the right funnel.

# What is the «Key Person Syndrome?»

The «Key Person Syndrome» is a term from business psychology. Let's break it down using an example of an ancient human settlement: people live their lives, fish, farm, and everything is going well. But one day, a global problem arises, such as a locust invasion or a drought. At this point, a more proactive individual steps up and offers a

solution. If their idea works, they'll be asked for help again when new problems arise, and with each successful solution, their influence grows.

# Why is it a problem?

Overreliance on a leader reduces the initiative of the group. As a result, the leader accumulates more power, while the society around them stops developing. Eventually, there will be no need for creativity or innovation.

# Any evidence to support this?

Let's consider a real-life analogy: parents who overprotect their children, doing everything for them and shielding them from all problems. They

often raise children who are not self-sufficient. On the other hand, people who tackled difficulties in childhood tend to grow into strong, resilient individuals.

It's exactly the same in management: if you shield your team from all problems and solve everything for them, you'll end up with a group that can't function without you.

But if you allow people to make mistakes and make decisions, without yelling at them like a maniac, they'll grow, and your company will become stronger.

# **Insights**

The main function of a leader is to develop more leaders. If your team isn't nurturing new leaders, your management won't get very far.

In our company, there are times when I don't even know we've launched a project or a new department, and I'm incredibly happy about it.

It doesn't matter how successful the project turns out to be. What's important is that it was launched without me, driven by the initiative of the team.

It's crucial to maintain the balance of leadership if you want to avoid being stuck in micromanagement and strive for your employees' development.

# **Recommendations:**

When someone comes to you with a problem, don't immediately tell them what to do. Instead, ask, «What would you do in this situation?»

- If the employee knows the solution, ask, «Why did you come to me if you already know what to do?»
- Fine-tune or expand on their idea. It's essential that employees learn how to make decisions and become more independent.
- When developing a strategy, don't dictate every step. Let your employees participate in creating the plan, think for themselves, and collaborate with other team members.
- Encourage initiative and independence. If someone from your team comes up with a new idea or suggestion, give them the chance to put it into action. Even if the idea doesn't work out, it will be a valuable learning experience that will help them grow as professionals.
- Provide constructive feedback. Instead of criticizing employees for mistakes, discuss how the result can be improved in the future.
- Delegate. This will free up your time for more strategic tasks, and your employees will grow by making decisions on their own.

# Micromanagement: For or Against?

In the short term, micromanagement might be more effective for managing a company, but in the long term, the one who invests in the team, allows mistakes, and helps employees grow will come out ahead.

# Analytics.

Campaign analytics is not an addition to your advertising strategy but its foundation. The results of your campaigns should always be monitored using various tracking tools i.e. Keitaro. These trackers allow you to see which offers, traffic sources, and funnels

are efficient, and which are not. This enables you to make informed decisions based on real metrics rather than intuition. Another way to gather useful data is to review your competitors' ad campaigns using spy tools. You can use tools like AdHeart, Tyver and other similar ones to spy on competitors' creatives and their offer promotion strategies.

# **Budget Management.**

Your budget is your primary resource, and managing it wisely will prevent you from going into the red. It's crucial to set limits for each traffic source and constantly monitor your advertising expenses. All you need is the ability to calculate profitability of your investments and have basic math skills. It's best to limit spending to 50% of the payouts you'll receive from the offer. This way you can minimize risks and increase your chances of achieving a positive ROI.

# Creatives.

Many beginners tend to take creatives as is from competitors via spy tools and use them in their campaigns without any modifications. This is a major mistake that can reduce the efficiency of your ad campaign, even if everything else is done correctly. If you use the same creatives, you won't be able to stand out among competitors, and potential customers will simply skip your ads. This is why it's important to create custom creatives for each offer to avoid "banner blindness" in your audience. Take into account the needs and pains of your target audience to resonate with them.

# Spy Tools.

Some beginner webmasters misuse spy tools by fully copying their competitors' advertising strategies. It's better not to rely solely on pre-made solutions, but to use them to hone your analytical skills and make your own creative banners. This way, you'll be able to devise personal advertising approaches and improve campaign results. Newcomers who misuse or ignore spy tools risk losing money because they won't be able to adapt to changing market conditions in time.

Building a personal brand is a creative process. Find your own identity which could be expressed in colors, photo styles, post formats, fonts and ways of communication.

### **Step #5.** Interactions.

Respond to comments and ask questions — people enjoy receiving feedback, and for you, this will boost your engagement with the audience without much effort.

### Step #6. Events.

Strive to show up on events whenever such opportunities arise. Conferences are a perfect mix

of both pleasant and valuable experiences which help to gather useful insights.

### Step #7. Collaborations.

Guest posts and interviews — these are excellent opportunities to showcase yourself as an expert and build invaluable connections.

# LEARNING FROM MISTAKES

### **Step #1.** Time for Math:

Hate to break it to you, but you can't do without analytics.. Track how different adjustments affect your traffic flow and audience engagement to find optimal solutions.

### Step #2. Handling Feedback.

Review feedback regularly. The fact that people are talking about you isn't always a good thing. If you're receiving the same feedback repeatedly, it's worth reflecting on it and making adjustments.

### Step #3. Making Changes.

Focus on what works well. Did your audience like the post? Then make it a regular feature. Otherwise, learn from it and move on.



There's a misconception that Discord is just a place where kids gather to play videogames, but that's not entirely true. The platform is becoming increasingly popular with a more affluent audience, making it worth considering as a traffic source.

Many webmasters are skeptical about Discord because it lacks an internal advertising system. Few people work with Discord, so competition is lower compared to other popular communication platforms. Additionally, getting through moderation on Discord is much easier than on platforms like Instagram or TikTok.

Currently, Discord ranks among the top 10 most popular social networks, and its functionality makes it especially attractive to gamers. The gaming industry is constantly growing and is expected to exceed \$680 billion by 2030.

Reaching your target audience is relatively easy since users group together based on shared interests on servers. Moreover, the audience is highly engaged and deeply immersed in the server topics. The target audience is quite similar to that of Twitch, primarily made up of affluent males aged 18-35. 65.02% of the audience are men, but there's a significant number of women as well — 34.98%. Their main interests include gaming, IT, crypto, programming, geek culture, news, and adult content.

The main geo is the US. Targeting Tier-1 countries requires a bigger budget as their audience is harder to attract. However, higher stakes bring better rewards. Tier-1 countries have the highest paying audience, so if you manage to engage users and direct traffic effectively, you'll see significant profits. While there are fewer users from Tier-2 and Tier-3 countries, they are still present.

# What verticals work well?

- Cyber betting and betting. Creatives featuring esports betting perform well on servers related to streams and news:
- Gambling. Casino apps disguised as casual games work effectively;
- App installs. Users are interested in convenient tech and new games;
- Crypto and finance. Many crypto enthusiasts are on Discord:
- Adult content. No surprise here, the majority of the audience is male.

### How to run traffic?

The only way here is organic traffic. There are various methods:

- Spam/crowd marketing in private messages and chats: manually or via spam bots;
- Streaming;
- Your own server. Create your own server, promote it, and use it to run traffic wherever you want;
- Use someone else's server. Spam is tolerated to a certain extent, but within reason.
